1 Corinthians 2:14-15 "Now the natural man receiveth not the things of the Spirit of God: for they are foolishness unto him; and he cannot know them, because they are spiritually judged. But he that is spiritual judgeth all things, and he himself is judged of no man."

1 Corinthians 3:1 "And I, brethren, could not speak unto you as unto spiritual, but as unto carnal, as unto babes in Christ. I fed you with milk, not with meat; for ye were not yet able (to bear it): nay, not even now are ye able; for ye are yet carnal: for whereas there is among you jealousy and strife, are ye not carnal, and do ye not walk after the manner of men?"

Mind of the flesh (ASV)

• Romans 8:6-7 "For to be carry mind is death; but to be spiritually minded is life and peace. Because the carried mind is enmity against God: for it is not subject to the law of God, neither indeed can be." KJV

To be spiritually minded is truly a matter of life and death!

Pneumatikos:

- a. When used of Persons.... "One who is filled with and governed by the Spirit of God" (Thayer 523).
- b. Vine says simply that "men in Christ who walk so as to please God are... 'spiritual'" (1088).

Natural Man VS. Spiritual Man 1 Cor. 2:14-15

- Natural man- One who has confidence in the flesh (human wisdom). 1 Corinthians 1:12-13, 18ff; 2:3-5; 3:3-4
 - -Glorifies self; jealousy, strife, contention. (cf. James 3:14-16)
- **Spiritual man-** One who has confidence in God. Titus 3:5
 - -Glorifies God; humility. (Philippians 2:5-8)
 - -No confidence in the flesh. (Philippians 3:1-15)
